Science Week

Christmas Performances

Every year we are asked for additional tickets. Due to fire regulations there is a limit to how many we can admit to each performance. So currently only 2 tickets can be booked per family and this can be difficult for split and blended families. We have a system for allocating spare tickets. Applications can be made using a request form very similar to those used for holiday requests. These are available from the school office. Please note online booking will close at 6.00pm on Friday 1st December and allocations of remaining tickets will be made after this date.

Christmas Fayre and Mufti Days

The Christmas Fayre is a well-loved annual event which really marks the beginning of the Christmas season at Broadway. It is also the main fundraising event of the year and takes an enormous amount of organisation and effort on the part of the Friends of Broadway. Accordingly, they should be very grateful for any help on the actual night or in preparation running up to the event. Thank you in anticipation.

There will be mufti days on Friday 10th and Friday 17th November. On the 10th November it is requested that Year 1 and Year 2 give items of stationary. Reception do not have to bring anything in on that day but instead, they are requested to give cakes for the Christmas fayre and bring them in on the morning of Friday 24th November. On the second mufti day there is a request for donations of tombola prizes from all year groups. All donations will be used to raise money for the Christmas fayre.

Parking and Waiting on Zig-Zag Markings.

Now a bit of a moan – cars are still being parked on the zig-zags outside school. Please note that if you do so between the hours of 8.00am and 5.00pm you are committing an offence. We always take photographs and pass them onto the Avon and Somerset Police. However, if you are dropping your child off at breakfast club before 8.00am in the morning you are not breaking any laws. In future, photographs will be published in the school newsletters. Remember parking on zig-zags reduces visibility, causes an obstruction and endangers children's lives. You could also be liable for a financial penalty. Please do not park here.

We ask that you phone the school office before 9.15am and provide a reason. A great deal of time is often wasted by the office staff who try to make contact with parents.
