This week the children have had a 'Be Bright Be Seen' assembly teaching them about the importance of wearing bright clothing when out in the dark. They learned about the difference between fluorescent and reflective clothing and how to cross the roads safely. Please encourage your child to wear something bright and take extra care when out and about near

roads, especially as nights draw in and visibility is reduced.


