Daily reading practise helps make your child a better reader.

Practising little and often makes the biggest impact on your child's progress.

Due to it being a short week, Champion Reader totals will be recorded and shared next week.

As a reminder your child brings home a colour banded book and a phonics book in their book bag as well as a small paper book. The paper book includes all the sounds and words they have been learning during the week in phonics lessons. There is also a sticker with a pin code stuck in your child's reading record which can be used to access phonics e-books.
